1. Your answers to the questions.
2. A simple budget in Excel format, submitted using the template you can download from our website.
3. A link to a two-minute recording introducing yourself and your innovation. You can use any online recording platform to share this. Find more guidance on our website.
4. *Optional:* Reports outlining the evidence for your innovation, and any supplementary attachments you wish to share.

Questions - Innovation

Thanks, your 25% done already! Now we'd like to know more about your innovation. In this section we are going to ask you about the problem you are addressing and your solution.

- 1) What problem is your innovation addressing? Please include examples of evidence that demonstrates the scale and urgency of the problem. (max 1000 characters)

- 2) What is your proposed solution to the problem? (max 1000 characters)

- 3) Please give details of where and how you have piloted and tested your innovation so far. You can include any milestones you have met so far? (max 800 characters)

- 4) What evidence have your pilot(s) or research generated, that shows that your innovation can deliver real-world impact? (max 400 characters)

- 5) Feel free to upload any supporting documentation that shows that your innovation can deliver real-world impact.

- 6) Has your pilot or innovation been subject to any external evaluation? Please give details. Note: An external evaluation is carried out by someone who is not directly involved in the development or operation of the organisation or innovation. (max 800 characters)

- 7) All innovations are subject to risks. Could you identify any risks related to your innovation? You will be asked specifically about any covid contingency plans you have in the next question. (max 800 characters)

- 8) What are your covid contingency plans? (max 800 characters)

- 9) What would you like your innovation to scale up to in the next 5 years? Please include a list of milestones you expect to achieve, with approximate dates. (max 800 characters)

Questions – Team Organisation

Thanks! Next, some questions on your team and your organisation.

- 1) Please give the names and job titles of 2-5 people who would participate in the introductory classes if you are selected. These should be the main people involved in developing and steering your innovation. You can include people from outside your organisation, if necessary. You will be able to change this later, if you are selected. **You can upload an organisation chart on the next question if you prefer.**

- 2) Please upload your organisation chart showing the structure of your organisation and relations between positions. This question is *optional* and will not affect the outcome of your application.

- 3) What partners or champions are supporting you with this project? This can include delivery partners, government organisations, partner NGOs, businesses, or individuals. Please list up to 5 key partners. (max 800 characters)

- 4) Will you need to partner with anyone else to achieve impact at scale? If so, please outline who they would be. (max 800 characters)

- 5) Who is the key decision maker on this project?
 - a) Me
 - b) My manager
 - c) Someone else within my organisation
 - d) Someone outside of my organisation

- 6) Is this innovation your organisation's only or main programme?

Questions – Budget and Recording

Nearly there! This is the final section.

Here we'll ask you for your budget, any links for sharing your work and a two-minute recording introducing yourself and your innovation.

- 1) Does your organisation have funding or commitments to support this innovation for the next 18 months at least, not including this Education Innovation Awards grant?

- 2) Please attach an outline budget showing how you would spend a £50,000 GBP grant on activities related to scaleup. Please download the Microsoft Excel template on our website. You will be able to update and change this budget if you are selected for the grant. We expect you to set aside between £10-15k for evidence generation activities.

- 3) *Optional:* Please provide your bank details including Account Name, Account Number and Sort Code. If you do not submit this information you must agree to provide it by the 24th June at the latest if you are shortlisted.

- 4) *Optional:* Please provide a summary of your most recent accounts including your total income and total expenditure. If you do not submit this information you must agree to provide it by the 24th June at the latest if you are shortlisted.

- 5) By clicking 'I accept' you confirm that you have provided your financial information and records or that you will provide them by 24th June 2021 if you are shortlisted.
